**State Auditor Colón and Team OSA Hits the Road  
for the 2019 Audit Rule Roadshow**

SANTA FE, NM – New Mexico State Auditor Brian Colón and members of Team OSA will hit the road beginning Wednesday, March 19<sup>th</sup> for its annual, statewide Audit Rule Roadshow. Each year the Office of the State Auditor (OSA) embarks on a statewide tour to provide training to governmental agency employees and independent public accountant (IPA) firm representatives to provide training on significant and critical updates to the [Audit Rule](#). This year, Auditor Colón and Team OSA will visit six cities across the state: Las Vegas, Las Cruces, Portales, Farmington, Taos, Santa Fe, and Albuquerque. Auditor Colón has invited distinguished guests from each stop on the tour to provide opening remarks at the training to be followed by Auditor Colón delivering a State of the OSA address, and will conclude with high-level training on the audit process, updates to the Audit Rule, and other technical auditing topics. The OSA recommends that each agency and IPA firm send appropriate personnel to the Audit Rule training. Representatives of the governing authority, top management, contracting personnel and employees of the finance division are encouraged to attend. Agencies will need to register online at [http://www.saonm.org/register\\_form](http://www.saonm.org/register_form) for one of the free training sessions. The Santa Fe training will have a morning and afternoon session to accommodate attendees. Each person in attendance may earn up to 3 hours of continuing professional education (CPE) credit for attending the Audit Rule training.
